Summer Term 2019 Sports Clubs Available:

Dance Club - (Monday - YR - Y2) - Rebecca Sheldon (External Provider)

In this dance club the children will learn different styles including street dance and musical theatre. The classes are fun and engaging. At the end of the term parents/carers will have the opportunity to watch the children perform what they have learnt.

Cricket - (Tuesday - Y1 - Y3) - Mr Mc Laughlin

Children are given the opportunity to learn key skills and take part in a full range of drills specifically designed for their level and ability. The children will learn how to throw, catch, field, bat, bowl and participate in mini-game situations.

<u>Skipping</u> - (Tuesday - Y1 - Y6) - Skipping Workshops - (External Provider)

Skipping is a great sport and is used as training by many world class athletes. It will help to improve your child's coordination, stamina, flexibility and balance. At the end of the term parents/carers will have the opportunity to watch the children perform what they have learnt.

Gymnastics - (Thursday - Y2 - Y6) - Good Life Gymnastics (External Provider)

This popular club returns for the summer term. The children will be able to develop their physical agility and coordination. They will work on sequence development, balances, floor work and also use the vault. We have a wide range of new equipment which will support the children's learning. At the end of the term parents/carers will have the opportunity to watch the children perform what they have learnt. The children from this club performed at the summer fair last academic year.

Yoga - (Thursday - YR - Y3) - Pip Bermingham

Children's yoga in a fun and non-competitive environment. Relaxing bodies and minds through yoga postures, breathing exercises and creative relaxations. Classes will enhance self-confidence, coordination and concentration.

Tennis - (Friday - Y4 - Y6) - Mr Mc Laughlin (AM club)

This therapeutic club will not only help the children develop their motor skills and critical thinking, but will help their focus, team working skills and interaction with others. The children will have projects to complete each week in either small groups, or as individuals. Although constructions will not be kept they will be photographed so parents/carers can see what their child has made.

Word Game - (Monday - Y4 - Y6) - Vida Stevens

The club aims to encourage your child's reading, spelling and strategic thinking skills. It will be a social opportunity and will develop your child's ability to share, communicate and develop their language. They will be playing games like Scrabble, Stop the Bus and Boggle.

Drama Club - (Monday - Y1 - Y2) - Miss Sarton

This new club promises to be exciting and inspiring. The children will have the opportunity to express themselves through singing and acting. They will develop their confidence, social interaction and team building skills. Parents/carers will be invited in from time to time to see what the children have been doing.

Art Club - (Tuesday - Y3 - Y6) - Natalie Kay (External Provider)

Participants will be exploring different genres of art and different mediums. They will be looking at famous artists and sculptures and learning new techniques.

The children enjoy their first experiences of French as we explore new language through songs, poems, drama, craft and games. We meet every Wednesday during the second half of lunch, and look forward to seeing lots of new faces. "A bientôt!"

<u>Ukulele Club</u> - (Wednesday - Y3 - Y6) - Kingston Music Service (External Provider)

This fantastic club is provided by Kingston Music Service. The club is suitable for beginners or those children in Y4 who would like some additional practice. Ukuleles do not need to be purchased as this is included in the cost, although you are welcome to buy one should your child be successful in gaining a place. In order for children to be able to take their instrument home you will be asked to complete a form to confirm that you are willing to take responsibility for the care of the instrument until the end of the term. Each pupil will be allocated a specific numbered ukulele for them to use. If an instrument is damaged or not returned you will be asked to replace it or be charged the cost of a replacement.

Chess Club - (Wednesday - Y2 - Y6) - Chess in Schools and Communities (External Provider)

This club is an ideal opportunity for your child to develop their strategic skills. They will learn the basic rules and compete against each other on a weekly basis.

Cooking Club - (Thursday Y1- Y3 and Friday - Y3 - Y6) - The Bejewelled Academy (External Provider)

The children will learn how to cook using a variety of recipes. They will be able to prepare, cook and taste a wide range of foods from different countries. The instructor is fully qualified to deliver these sessions.

<u>Choir</u> - (Thursday - Y3 - Y6) - Miss McLean
