
Monitoring

The impact of PPG expenditure is measured through:

- Data analysis Tracking attainment and progress
- Analysis of Pupil Attitudes to Self and School (PASS) survey and other pupil voice activities
- Tracking of behaviour incidents
- Regular progress meetings with class teachers

Impact

• Progress of Pupil Premium children in Years 1-6 was broadly in line with non Pupil Premium children in both Reading and Writing. The group made the school expected 4 Average Point Score (APS) progress in Maths.



- This information is available by Year Group in the school's assessment records.
- At the end of KS2 (total cohort of 11 pupils):

100% of Pupil Premium children achieved L4 and 43% achieved L5 in Reading. 100% of Pupil Premium children achieved L4 Writing, 43% achieved a L5 in Writing. 86% of Pupil Premium children achieved L4 and 43% achieved L5 in Maths.
