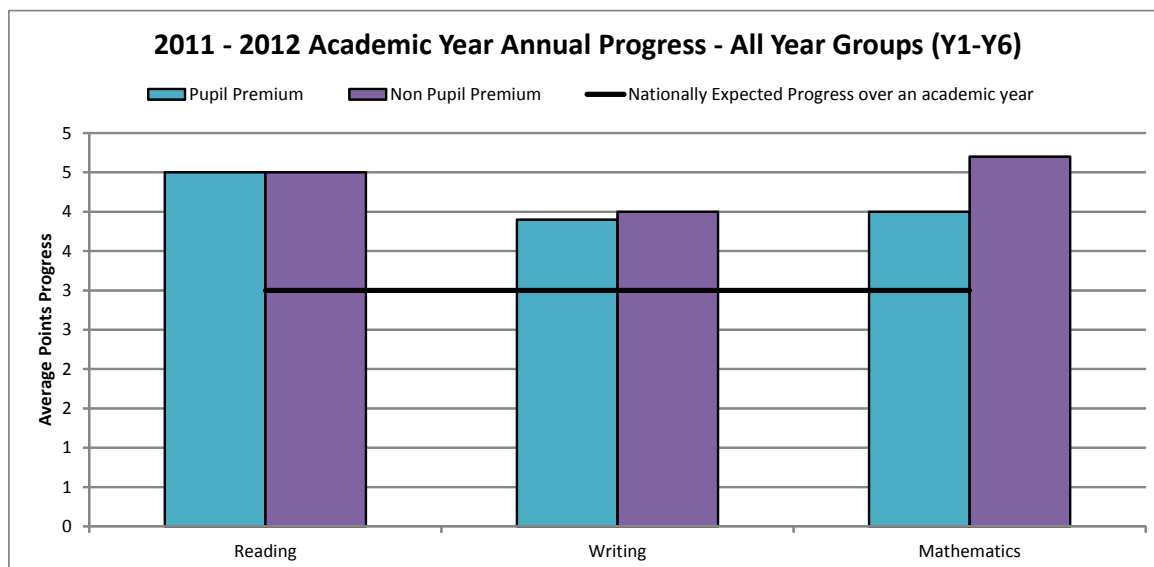

## Impact

- Progress of Pupil Premium children in Years 1-6 was broadly in line with non Pupil Premium children in both Reading and Writing. The group made the school expected 4 Average Point Score (APS) progress in Maths.



- This information is available by Year Group in the school's assessment records.

- At the end of KS2 (total cohort of 11 pupils):

*100% of Pupil Premium children achieved L4 and 43% achieved L5 in Reading.*

*100% of Pupil Premium children achieved L4 Writing, 43% achieved a L5 in Writing.*

*86% of Pupil Premium children achieved L4 and 43% achieved L5 in Maths.*

- The school has identified progress in maths as Key Issue in the SDP for 2012-13.
- RWI has worked successfully as an intervention and will now be rolled out in KS1 and EYFS as main phonics programme.
- 1:1 tuition and year 6 interventions will be continued next year.
