We are delighted to let you know that the KS2 Choir will be performing at the Kingston Schools Singing Festival 2025, which will take place at the Rose Theatre on **Wednesday 18th June**. The concert will begin at **4.15pm** and will finish at approximately **5.45pm**. Children will have lunch at school as usual, and we will then walk to the Rose Theatre to arrive by **1.30pm** for the afternoon rehearsal. All children should wear **full school uniform** with **sensible walking shoes** (no trainers, please), and bring a refillable **water bottle** and a **healthy snack** to have after the rehearsal.

Please note that **all children** will need to be collected from the Rose Theatre after the concert. We will not be returning to school. More details about the exact collection point will be confirmed at the end of the concert, but this is usually either the front or side entrance.

Please go to ParentPay to consent for your child to attend. There is no cost for this event, but tickets for the performance are now available to purchase from the Rose Theatre website. Please book asap to avoid disappointment.
