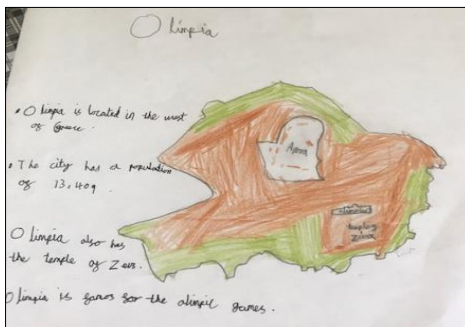

- 1: The official name of Greece is Hellenic Republic with a population of around 11 million.
- 2: There are thousands of islands in Greece but only about 200 are inhabited. Crete is the largest.
- 3: Greek culture has developed over thousands of years, most notably Classical Greek and through the influence of the Roman Empire with its Greek Eastern continuation, the Byzantine Empire.



Greek Cookery uses vegetables, olive oil, grains, fish, meat and wine. Greek people consume more olive oil than any other nation in the world so if you love olive oil, Greece is the best place to go. Other important ingredients include olives, pasta, cheese, lemon juice, herbs, bread and yogurt. Common desserts include nuts, honey, fruits and filo pastry.

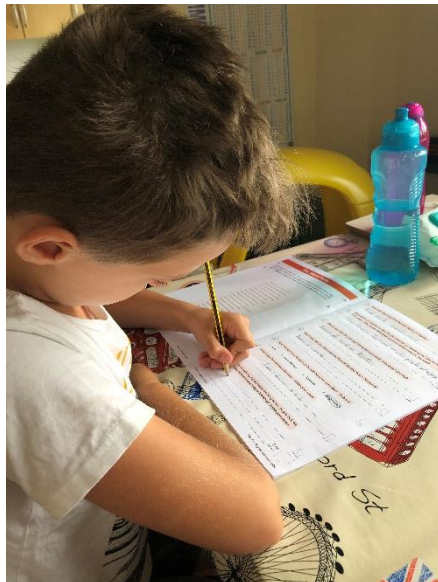
