

























## Face Masks in School

					
<p>From 8<sup>th</sup> March all adults in school will be asked to wear a face mask.</p>	<p>This includes school staff, visitors, parents and carers.</p>	<p>This is good - it will help to keep everyone safe.</p>	<p>A few adults cannot wear a face mask for special reasons.</p>	<p>This is OK. If most people wear one, everyone will still be safe.</p>	<p>Adults will wear a mask when they move around the school.</p>
					
<p>Most adults will not wear a face mask in the classroom or office where they mainly work.</p>	<p>A few adults might wear a face mask in their classroom or office for special reasons.</p>	<p>This is OK - it makes sure everyone is as safe as possible.</p>	<p>Children do not need to wear a face mask at all at school.</p>	<p>A few children in Year 6, who are 11 years old, might wear one to get to school on the bus.</p>	<p>This is good. They are following the rules.</p>
					
<p>Some younger children might wear a mask on the way to school.</p>	<p>This is OK. They must give their mask to their parent or carer before they say goodbye.</p>	<p>Everyone will keep their re-usable masks in a sealed bag or container when they are not wearing it.</p>	<p>Disposable masks must be thrown away in bins with lids only.</p>	<p>Everyone will wash or sanitise their hands before and after touching their mask.</p>	<p>This helps stop germs spreading.</p>
					
<p>It might be strange to see adults wearing masks in school.</p>	<p>We will soon all get used to it.</p>	<p>This rule will be reviewed at Easter to decide if we need to carry on wearing masks.</p>	<p>If you are worried or have questions you can speak to the adults in your bubble.</p>	<p>Even though you can't see,</p>	<p>we are all still smiling under our masks!</p>
