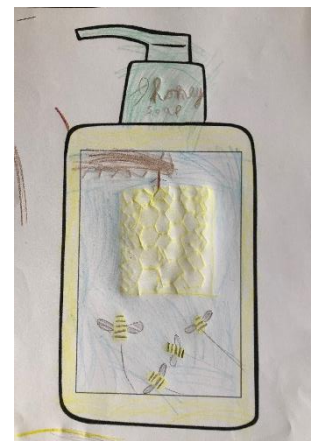
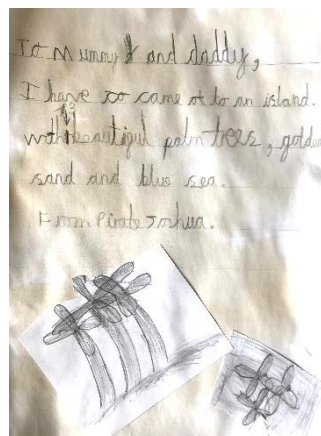
Hugh designed his robot on paper. With help from Dad, he has now built it to his design.
