Year 2	<p><u>'Where do we belong?'</u></p> <p>Learning and singing a range of Folk songs from the UK and beyond.</p>	<p><u>'Diary of a London Kid'</u></p> <p>Learning a range of songs about 'The Great Fire of London' and creating soundscapes based on the event.</p>	<p><u>'Brave Explorers'</u></p> <p>Learning songs from Disney films with brave heroes. Creating group compositions based on brave explorers such as Ellen Macarthur.</p>
