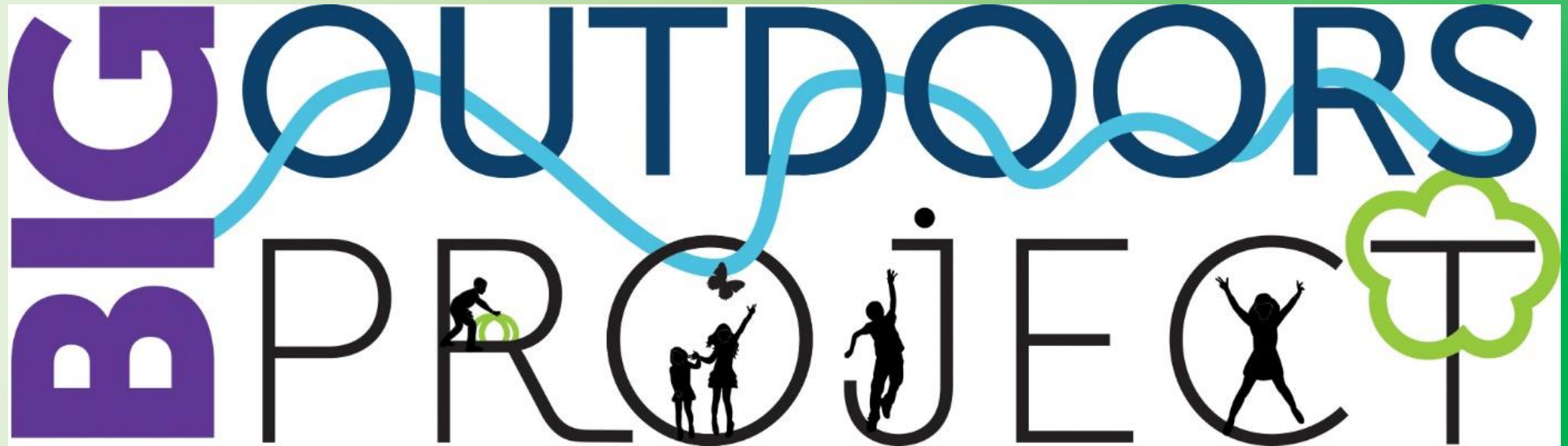

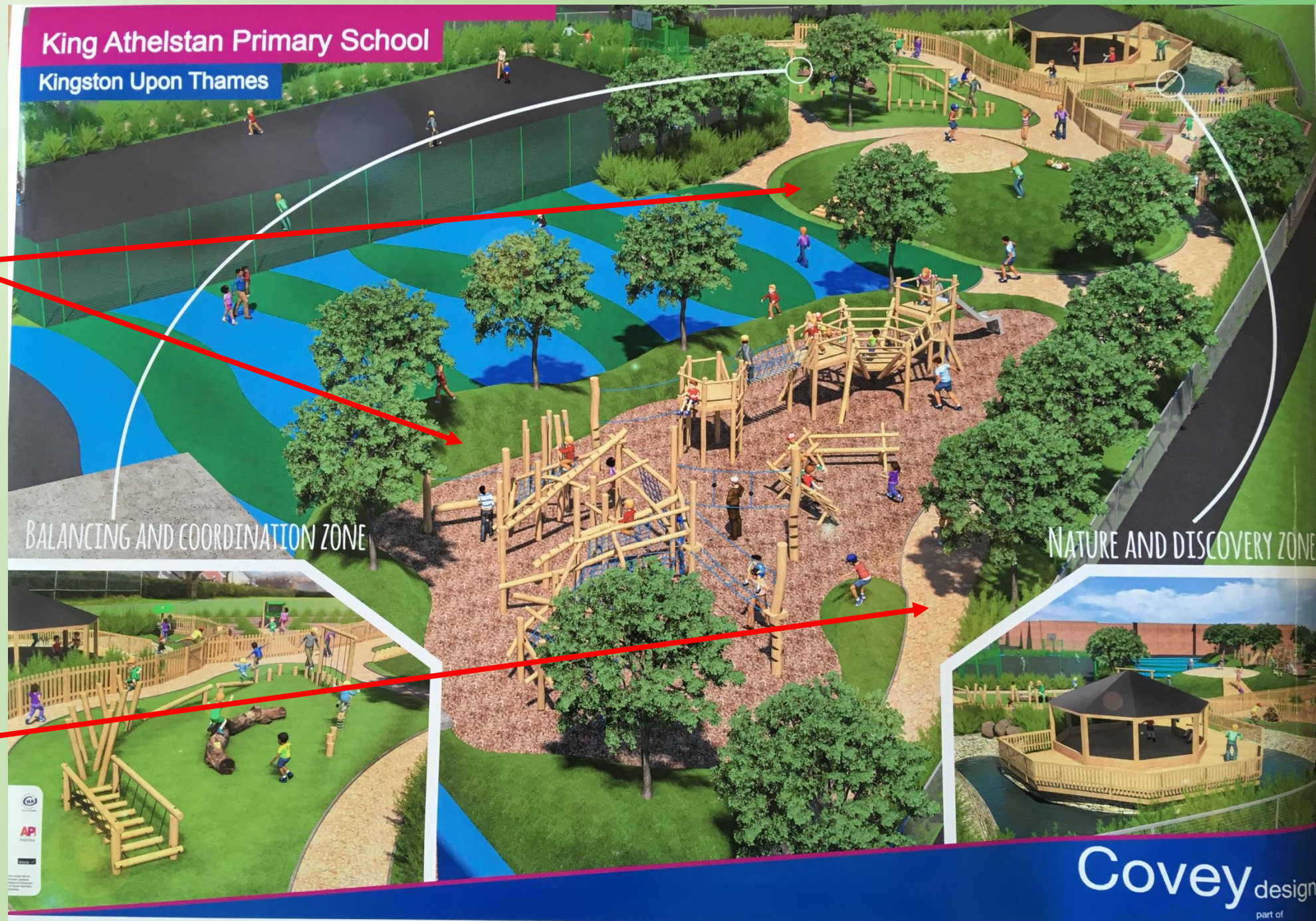

- Hill and mounds to create a more interesting space
- Surfacing across the whole area allows year round access. This includes a mixture of artificial grass and other durable surfacing
- There is a 'Daily mile' track, which is a continuous path around the playground



Current trim trail



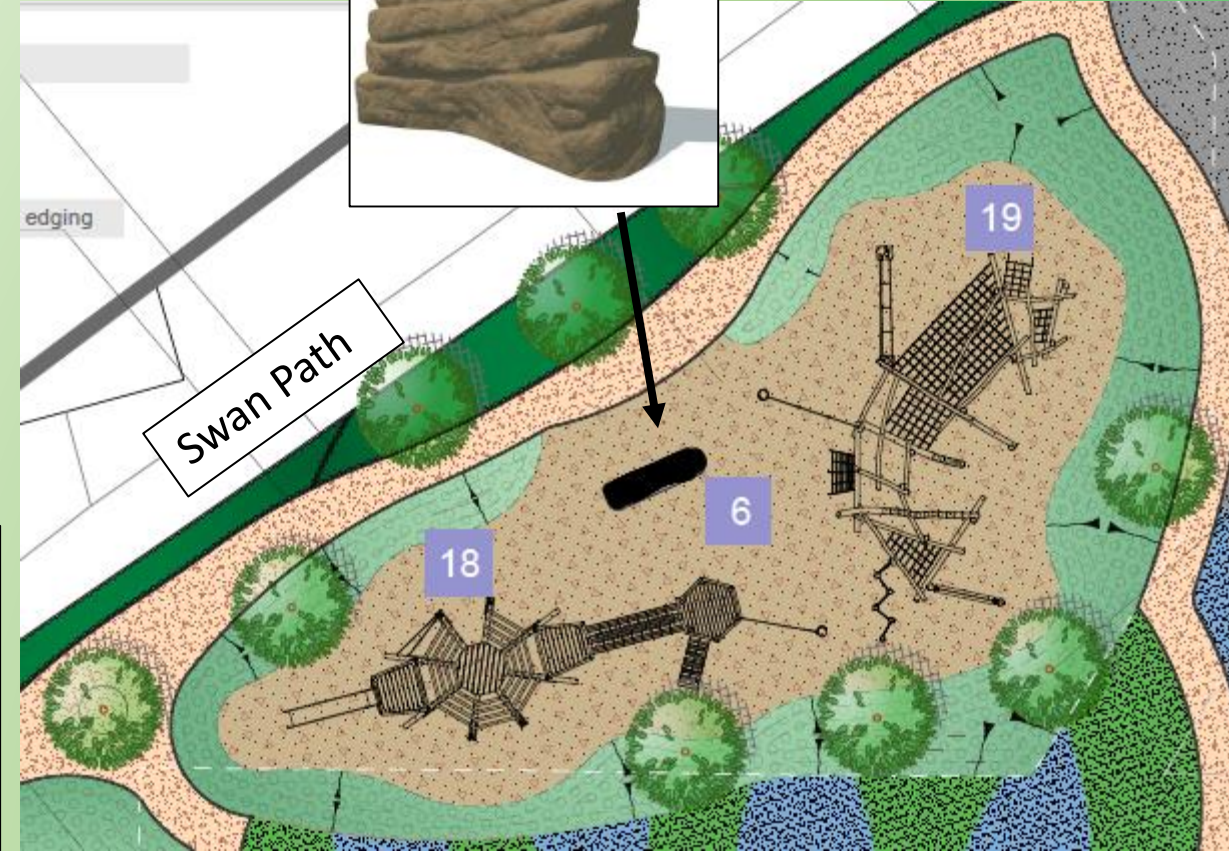
NB: design view is taken from Swan Path

Seated circle replaced by climbing boulder for greater play opportunities.

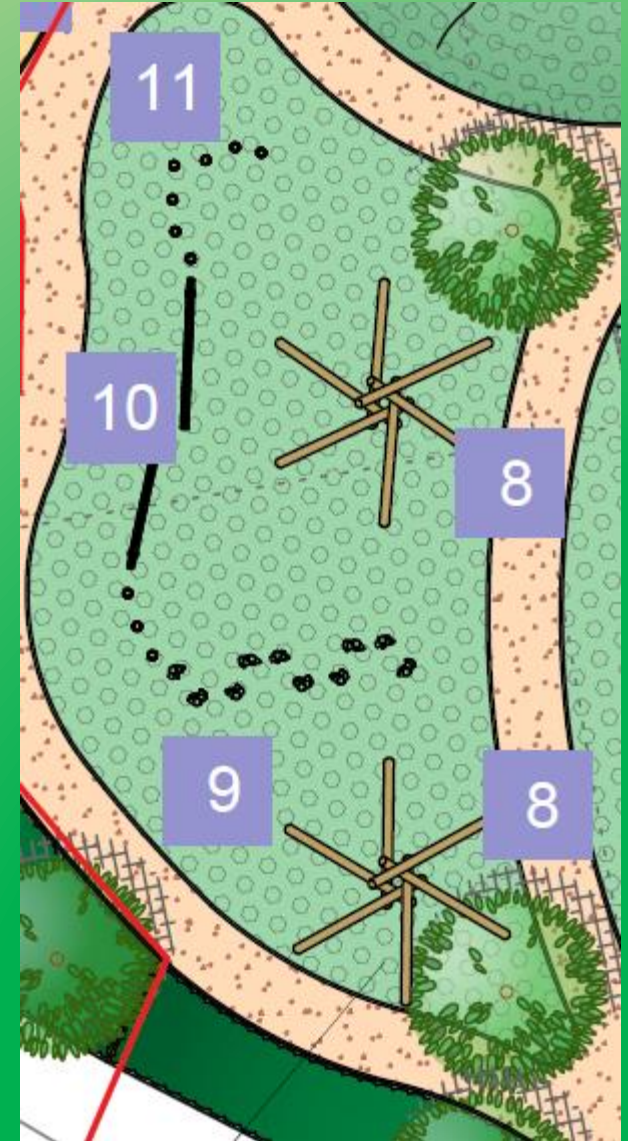
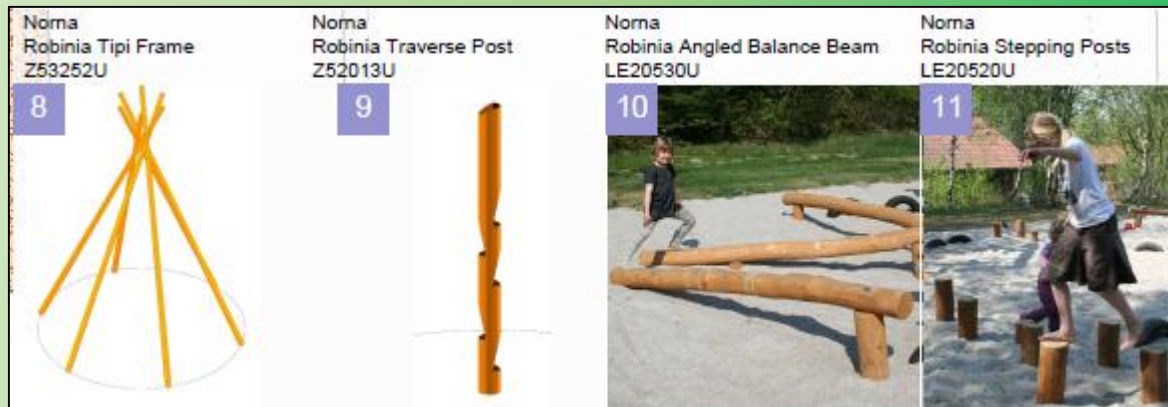
New Adventure area Funded by the PCSA



Adventure spaces with physical equipment as above which encourage exploration, challenge and risk taking for 7-11 year olds.

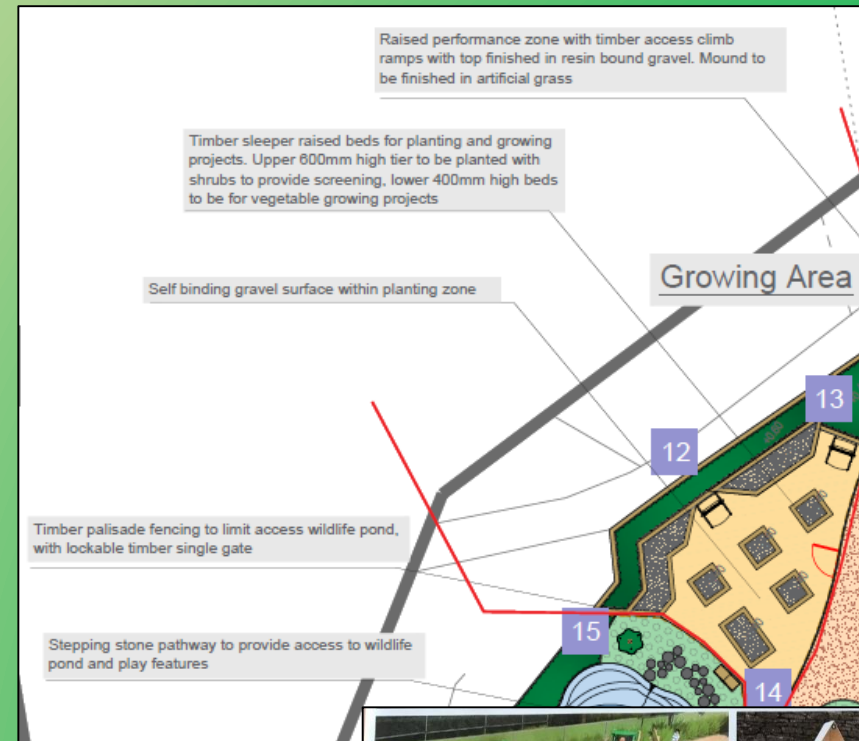
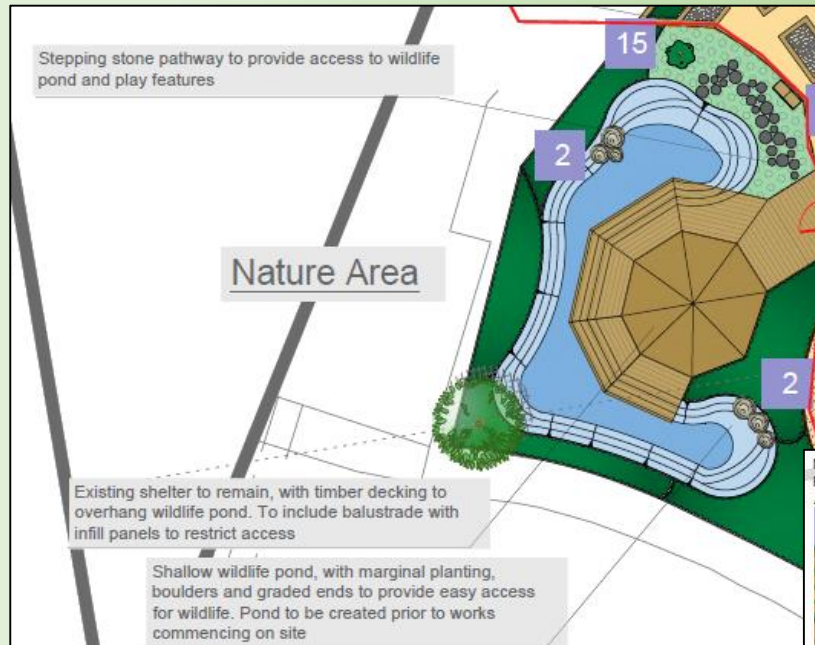
