Sports Day Years 1-6

Sports Day is an important date in the King Athelstan calendar and we would like to invite you to join us in supporting and cheering for your children on **Thursday 26**th **June**. Sports Day is the perfect opportunity to celebrate the children's achievements and give everyone a chance to take part and shine. EYFS Sports Day (Nursery and Reception) will take place onsite on Wednesday 25th June - a separate letter has been sent to EYFS families.

On **Thursday 26**th **June**, Sports Day for Y1-6 will be taking place off-site at the Athelstan Recreation Ground, a short walk up Villiers Road. Children should come to school at their normal time. After school clubs will be running as normal.
