Thank you for your interest in volunteering at King Athelstan Primary School; we really appreciate support from parents and carers and volunteers in our community. Volunteers will be asked to carry out 1:1 reading with individual children, usually located just outside the classroom. Signing in and Safeguarding:

All volunteers must have a current DBS certificate through the school and must have read the safeguarding leaflet. Please sign in and out each time you come to the office.

Covid-19 Specific requirements:

All adults in school must adhere to any coronavirus restrictions in place, which may include wearing masks and/or taking lateral flow tests. Adults must support and remind the children to adhere to any restrictions.

Parent/Carer Volunteers:

If your child attends King Athelstan, you will not be working in the same classroom as your child, however you may be asked to complete admin or take 1:1 readers from their class.

School Ethos:

We have a strict 'no shouting' policy at our school and believe supporting children who are not ready to learn. If you feel that a child needs support with their behaviour please seek help from a teacher or a teaching assistant rather than trying to resolve the situation yourself.

Break and Lunch:

Volunteers may use the front office to make a drink during any break times, as the staff room is reserved for King Athelstan Staff only.

Absence:
