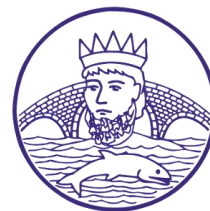

Dear Families of Y2,

Our topic this term is 'Where do we Belong?' To support our learning, we have organised a trip to **Bushy Park on Wednesday 19th November 2025.**

Key Information

- Your child will be travelling to and from Bushy Park by bus
- Please pay £12.93 on ParentPay
- Order lunch on ParentPay or provide a packed lunch

During this day, children will learn about a variety of habitats and micro-habitats. They will investigate how living things are adapted to the environment they live in and how their habitats help them to survive. The children will have the opportunity to identify a range of plants and invertebrates and investigate how they interact with each other.

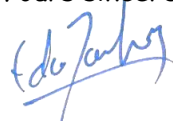
We will be travelling by bus, leaving school at 9:00am and will return for normal pick up time. If it is very wet there is the opportunity for us to be under shelter. However, this is an **outdoor activity** and it is important that your child wears appropriate clothing and footwear for a day spent outside. Children should **not wear uniform** but come in a set of clothes that you will not mind them getting muddy! Your child needs to wear trousers or track suit bottoms with wellington boots/trainers and a warm, waterproof coat; no jeans please.

The trip will cost **£12.93** which covers the cost of the activities. Please pay and give consent by Monday 4th November via ParentPay. Although this is a voluntary contribution, if we are unable to secure funds to cover the costs the trip may have to be cancelled. There is, as always, the option to make voluntary overpayments for trips in ParentPay to support others.

If you would like the school to prepare a packed lunch for your child, please book this on ParentPay in the usual way. Alternatively, please provide a lunch in a named disposable bag, and don't forget to cancel any lunch booking previously made. No fizzy drinks or sweets, please.

If you have a current **DBS** check by King Athelstan Primary School and would like to volunteer to help with this visit, please also indicate this on ParentPay. We are very grateful for your help, and will confirm volunteers as soon as we can.
