Dear Families of Y3,

As part of our topic, 'Do Machines Dream of Electric Sheep?', Year 3 will be taking a trip to the Science Museum on **Friday 12<sup>th</sup> June**. On the trip we will be:

- Experiencing a 'Feel the Force' show to enrich our science learning
- Exploring the 'Wonderlab' by becoming hands on scientists

To get to the Science Museum, we will walk to Norbiton station and take the train to Wimbledon. We will then change to the tube and travel on the District Line to South Kensington. We will leave school straight after morning registration and aim to be back at school by **4:15 pm** at the latest.

All children will need a packed lunch. If you book a lunch on ParentPay in the usual way, a packed lunch will be provided. Alternatively, please send a packed lunch from home in a disposable bag (and don't forget to cancel any hot meal booking already made). Please provide a refillable bottle of water - no fizzy drinks or sweets.



Children should wear full smart school uniform with black school shoes/trainers. Please ensure your child is already wearing sun cream on arrival at school as we will be walking to and from stations.

The cost for this trip is **£5.26**. Although this is a voluntary contribution, if we do not receive enough to cover the costs we may have to cancel the trip. Please pay on ParentPay. In ParentPay you will also see a separate option to overpay the amount, as requested by some parents. This is for anyone who wishes to pay extra to help families who may struggle with the cost, and this will help to ensure trips are not cancelled due to funding issues.

Please complete the permissions box in ParentPay. If you have a current DBS check through King Athelstan and you would like to support us on this trip please also indicate this in ParentPay. We are very grateful for assistance on trips and will confirm helpers as soon as we can.
