Please ensure you make childcare arrangements for any younger children for the duration of the performance. Siblings in school will see the show during school and do not need to attend the above performances.

Please be aware that the taking of photographs and filming during the productions is not permitted in order to maintain the safety and security of our children. You are very welcome to take individual photographs or film footage of your own child after the performance. As in previous years, there will be a professional recording which will be made available to Y6 families this year via an online 'shop'. Professional portrait photos will also be available. It will cost £15 for the show recording and one photo of your child in costume. Details of how to access this shop will follow - each family will be given a unique code to access their child's photo only.

School may also take some photos and add them to Google classroom in the usual way. It is important that you are happy for your child's individual photo to be taken both by the school and the professional photographer. All group photos will be included unless you advise us as a matter of
