


### Spotlight on Learning in Year 1

In English we have been immersing ourselves in the traditional fairy tale "Little Red Riding Hood". We received a phone call from the Woodcutter as he had heard screams in the woods! We then wrote some amazing instructions to Grandma's house under pressure, as we could hear the wicked wolf pacing outside.



In maths, we further secured our addition knowledge with "first, then and now" augmentation stories. We then began learning how to subtract using "first, then and now" reduction stories. Our teachers were so impressed with how well we understood the concepts.


