This week we have been thinking about Remembrance and yesterday each class held a very special assembly for Armistice Day. Our children watched the laying of wreaths at the Cenotaph and at 11am, we held two minutes silence. I know that the children have been very moved by some of the stories shared regarding the World Wars and all those who have fought in many conflicts around the world. Year 6 honoured the memory of the men and women who



fought and worked in World War One in preparation for Remembrance Day. "Mr Barson helped us to learn about local men who fought in the war and we shared our thoughts about the wider impact they have had on our lives and the importance to remember sacrifices people made and are still making". Each child made a poppy and wrote the name of a fallen soldier on it. These were proudly displayed on Remembrance Day.

Next week, our thoughts will turn to National Anti-Bullying Week, starting with Odd Socks Monday. Class teachers will teach lessons over the week focusing on the theme, 'One Kind Word'. They will also be discussing with the children the prevention of bullying, how to deal with issues if and when they arise and how bullying is different to falling out with friends.
