Christmas Lunch

Our Christmas Lunch is on **Thursday 21st December**. Please book ParentPay as usual, however the original menu selections will still be visible and not the menu changes. To book this special meal on ParentPay:

- choose the meat option (chicken burger) for your child to have roast turkey
- choose the veggie option (cheese and tomato pizza) for your child to have <u>festive veg pinwheel</u>
- jacket Potatoes will not be served on this day. However, we are unable to remove this option from ParentPay. If you select jacket potato for your child they will be served the veggie option on the Friday.
- if you select a side it will be chicken/veggie chipolatas, roast potatoes, parsnips, brussels sprouts, carrots, garden peas, sage & onion stuffing & gravy
- If you select dessert it will be chocolate celebration cake or mince pie and custard

Menu swap day

Because we are serving a roast lunch on the Thursday 21st December, we will be wusono swapping our usual Thursday menu (chicken burger or cheese and tomato pizza) to the day before, so to book lunch on Wednesday 20th December:

- choose the meat option (roast chicken) for your child to have chicken burger
- choose the veggie option (Quorn roast) for your child to have cheese and tomato pizza
- jacket potatoes will be available as usual on this day
- if you select a side it will be wedges, baked beans garden peas
- if you select dessert it will be flapjack
