SIMs App for Parents/Carers

Breakfast Club

Breakfast Club is open from 7.45 to 8.45 daily, and is located in the King Athelstan Centre at the back of the School. The children are given a choice of breakfasts such as cereals, fruit, porridge, eggs, toast and juice and undertake a mixture of fun and educational activities, outside when the weather permits. The charge is currently £6.50 per day. The Breakfast Club is run by King Athelstan Staff, and
