Sarah Cantrell from Story Storks delivered a wonderful one-woman show all about King Athelstan and his coronation in 925AD. We learned that Athelstan was the grandson of Alfred the Great, he was the first Anglo-Saxon king of all England, the first king to wear a crown and the first to issue a coin bearing his image. He reigned from 924



until 939AD. All the children joined in the Viking 'battles' in the hall - their participation was amazing. The children in KS2 also met with Sarah to brainstorm some ideas for the celebration of his coronation, which the whole school will be involved in on 19^{th} June. The event will mark 1100 years since his coronation.
