SIMs App for Parents/Carers

You will have received an email this week about the new SIMs Parent App asking you to set up an account. The Sims Parent App is a secure and convenient way for you to regularly check your child's details held by school, and update where necessary, so that school always has the correct information. This information includes home

address, parent/carers telephone numbers and email addresses and also the correct details of any other emergency contacts. Please ensure you check the information for each of your children before submitting. Along with the email, we sent a user guide which outlines how to get started with the app and what steps to take.
