A few reminders for the new school year in September:

- Our new footwear policy starts officially. We have sent out lots of information about this: only plain black footwear at all times. Children may wear plain black trainers (including soles) every day as well as on PE days. Children may continue to wear plain black school shoes on non-PE days if they wish. No coloured trainers or other footwear are permitted.
- Only sweatshirts/cardigans with the school logo may be worn. No other non-logo sweatshirts or cardigans are allowed. Second-hand uniform is available from the PCSA <u>HERE</u>.
- Children must not bring backpacks or rucksacks to school as we do not have room to store them.
- Children do not need to bring their own pencil cases they will be asked to take these home.
